## Solid Waste Management

## Biodegradable Compost Pits

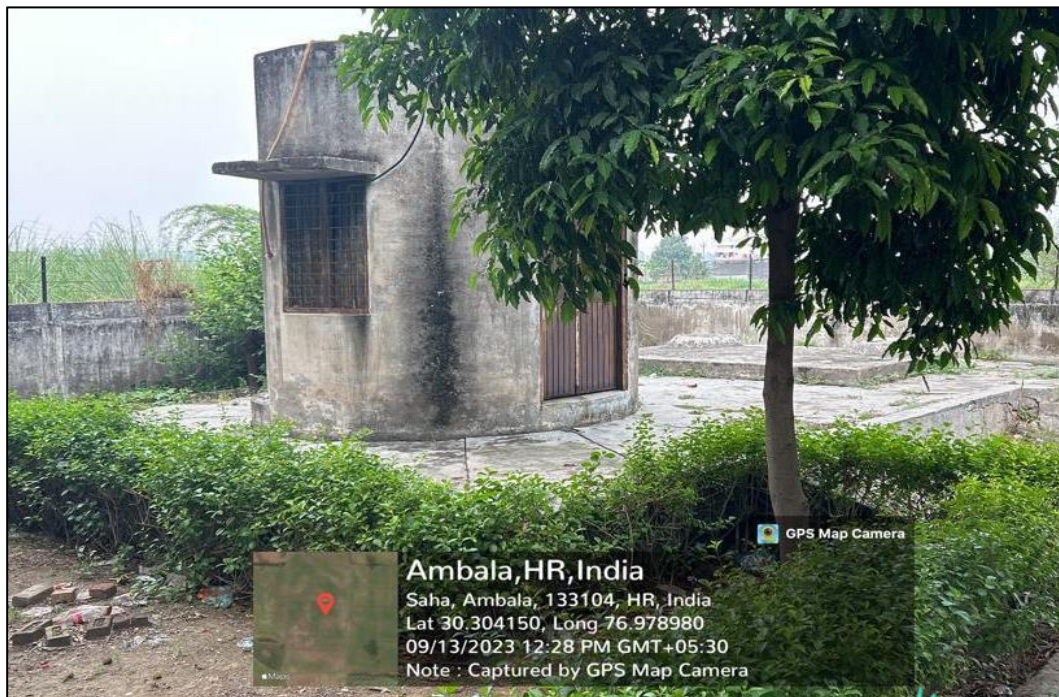
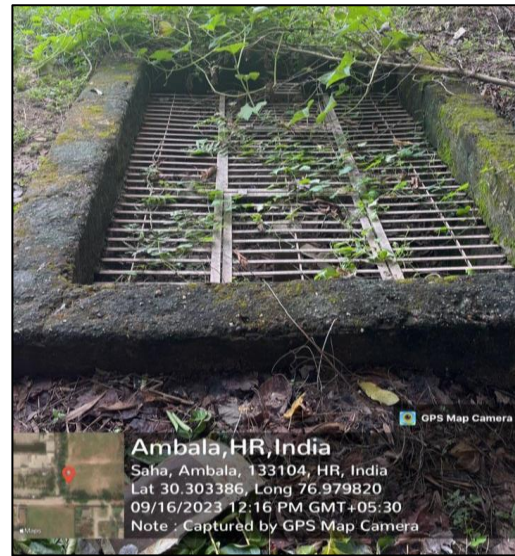
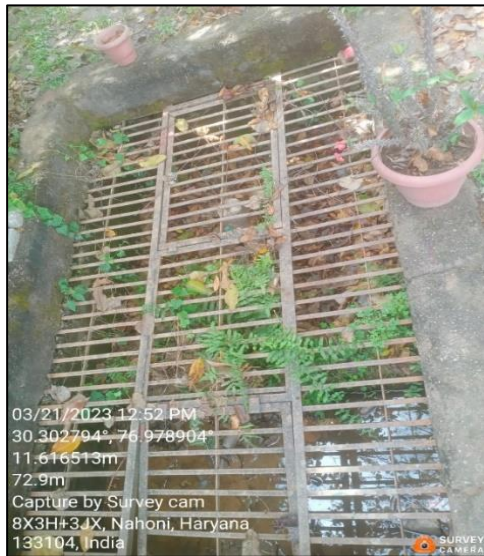
- Biodegradable wastes such as fallen leaves are dumped in composting pits to facilitate formation of natural manure to nurture plants in the campus.

## Liquid Waste Management
